



UPDATE: March 23, 2020

Dear Clients and Guests,

As stated in our previous statement, Great Life Counseling Center (GLCC) is committed to prioritizing the health and safety of our clients, team members, and guests. Due to concerns regarding the spread of the Coronavirus in our community, Dallas County officials issued a shelter-in-place order to go in effect at 11:59pm on March 23, 2020. In compliance with these orders, we are temporarily closing our office doors to clients and the public, effective immediately.

Although the order is scheduled to end on April 3rd, we are anticipating it will be extended further. Therefore, all of Great Life Counseling Center services will be provided via telehealth until April 24th. Of course, if things improve sooner than predicted, we will publish a celebratory statement regarding the change in plans.

Moving forward, the Great Life team will continue to brainstorm creative ways in which we can continue to be a resource and support to our clients, colleagues, and other members of the Dallas community during this time of uncertainty.
